ICT Equipment Use:

(ICT Equipment is defined as desktop computers, laptops, iPads, robotics, printers, smartphone, smart watches and any peripheral devices)

I agree to:

- **NOT** disclose my password to any other student
- **NOT** use any other student's password for any reason
- follow all teacher instructions when using equipment
- treat the equipment with care and respect at all times
- not use language or images that may be considered offensive or inappropriate
- only access files that are mine or files that a teacher has directed me to access
- keep the settings of the equipment as I find them and not to alter the visual display or any of the file settings
- not create, modify, hide or delete files or folders that are unnecessary to my class work **and/or** change the way equipment or its programs operate
- print only when instructed to by a teacher
- not create and/or install **any** programs/files (eg software, viruses, games, movies, batch files, chatroom creation) onto any equipment unless instructed to by a teacher
- not create, install or modify programs/files that affect another student's work or equipment.

Internet Use:

I agree to:

- access websites and search engines appropriate to the task
- not play games, extension or web-based, while directed to do an activity
- not download any files from the internet
- use only email programs associated with my DoE account on school ICT equipment
- not participate in any social media unless organised by and authorised by the teacher
- not provide my name, another student's name or any other personal details to any website
- **immediately** inform a teacher if I accidentally encounter on my or any other ICT equipment anything which I know is inappropriate or makes me feel uncomfortable.
