COVID-19 Latest department guidelines

We recently sent out the latest COVID-19 guidelines to everyone via the Skoolbag app. As a reminder, students should not be at school unless;

- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe
- they are currently unwell

In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu like symptoms to be sent home.

NSW Health have requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics. Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.

Please email the school a screen shot of the negative test result, identifying the child and if possible, date of birth, the day before your child returns to school.

As always, all student absences require written explanation. Please supply a note with your child on their return to school.

Additional information of interest to you includes:

- All group singing (choirs) and/or other chanting activities, as well as the use of wind instruments in group settings, are not permitted.
- P&C meetings and events must be on-line only.
- Students may attend other schools for essential curriculum related reasons or placements (e.g. auditions or placement tests).







My mind flashed with memories;


I recalled the times I climbed trees,


